

WARRANTY TERMS FOR INNER TUBES PRODUCED BY KABAT IN BUDZYŃ

I. INNER TUBES COVERED BY WARRANTY:

The warranty covers all inner tubes that are manufactured and sold by Kabat, provided that they are used as intended. Inner tubes are intended for *maintaining the required internal pressure used in a tyre*^{*}.

The warranty does not apply to inner tubes that have been repaired or show signs of repair.

^{*}"used in a tyre" means the wheel of a vehicle or other device that uses an inner tube in a tyre mounted on a rim.

II. SCOPE OF WARRANTY:

If any inner tube covered by this warranty becomes unusable, within a scope of that the manufacturer can check, it will be replaced with an equivalent new inner tube.

Some examples of causes or conditions that the manufacturer cannot control and that cannot be used as a basis:

- Cuts and pinches that occurred while assembling the inner tube in a tyre
- Cuts from the rim or tyre bead – rim slip
- Valve corrosion
- Clear overload or incorrect initial inflation
- Foreign bodies in the tyre chamber
- Intended changes in use (other than in the tyre)
- Ageing (or improper storage)
- Punctures
- Cuts
- Impacts
- Valve or valve stem ripped out
- Incorrect use (e.g. incorrect tyre size, type, etc.)
- Other incorrect care or use

The reasons and conditions provided above constitute grounds for rejecting the user's warranty claims. Kabat reserves the right to inspect the tyre (or wheel) before honouring an inner tube warranty claim.

III. WARRANTY PERIOD:

Kabat inner tubes are covered by a two-year (24-month) warranty from the date of sale; however, this may not be longer than 36 months from the date of production.

As part of the warranty, Kabat will refund the cost of the inner tube or replace it for an inner tube free of defects. Limitations:

- Does not apply to the costs of replacing the damaged inner tube, or tyre
- Does not apply to loss of time, vehicle operation, machine operation, profit or inconvenience
- Does not apply to payment of overtime, weekend work or holiday work for staff performing servicing or replacement
- Does not apply to costs of lost ballast or liquid (if used)
- Does not apply to any other damage

IV. OBLIGATIONS OF THE OWNER-USER:

It is the user's obligation to use the inner tube correctly, taking into account the maximum load and speed index specified for the tyre in which the inner tube is installed, and to use the inner tube in a manner that guarantees proper care and correct use for tyres and inner tubes.

For a complaint to be considered, the owner-user must provide Kabat with a photo of the inner tube and a completed COMPLAINT FORM. Kabat reserves the right to inspect the inner tube based on a photo or to request the physical delivery of the inner tube to KABAT. A photo of the damaged inner tube must show the location of the damage, size and identification number of the inner tube.

Other forms of complaint submission – only after prior agreement between the interested parties.
